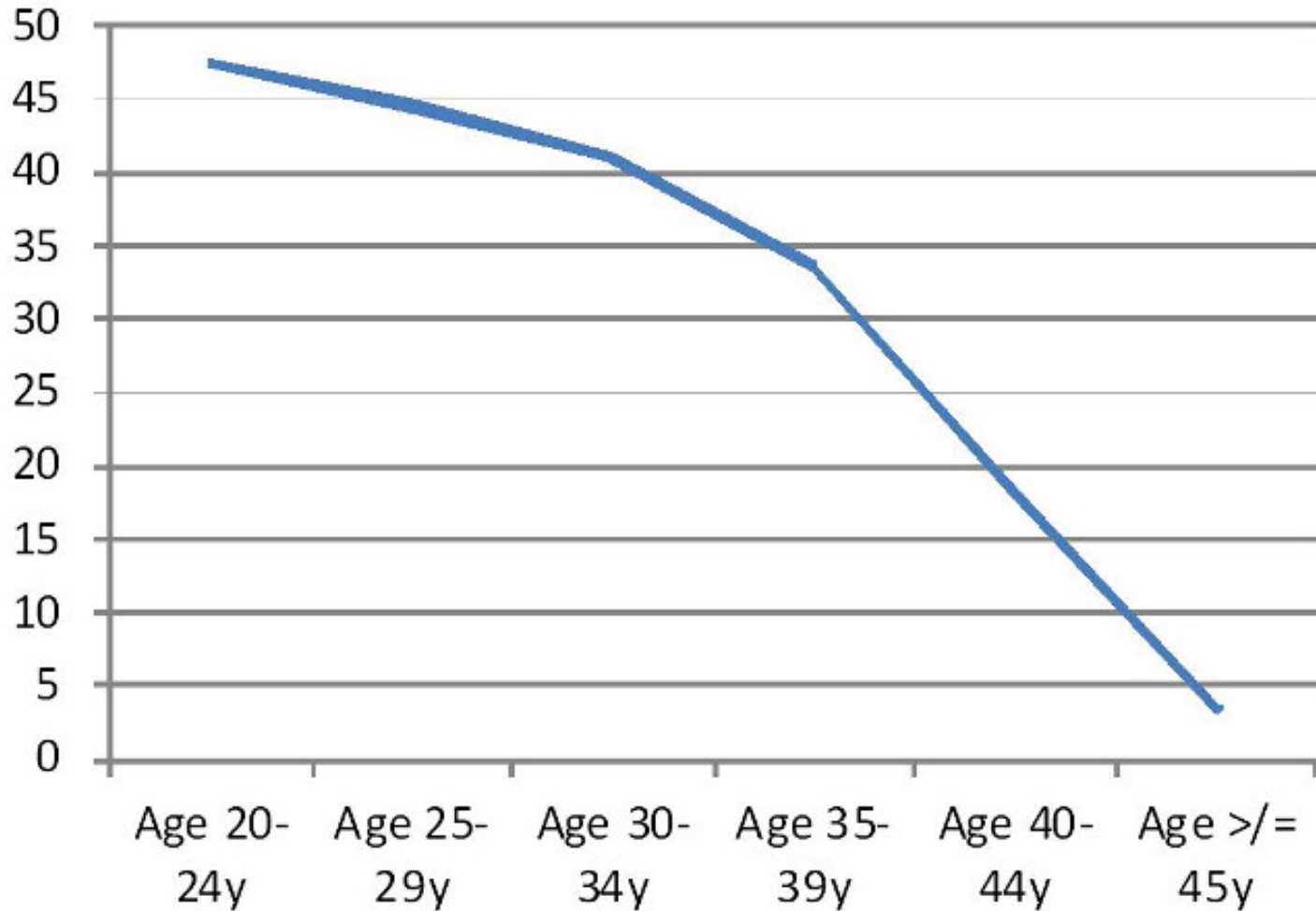


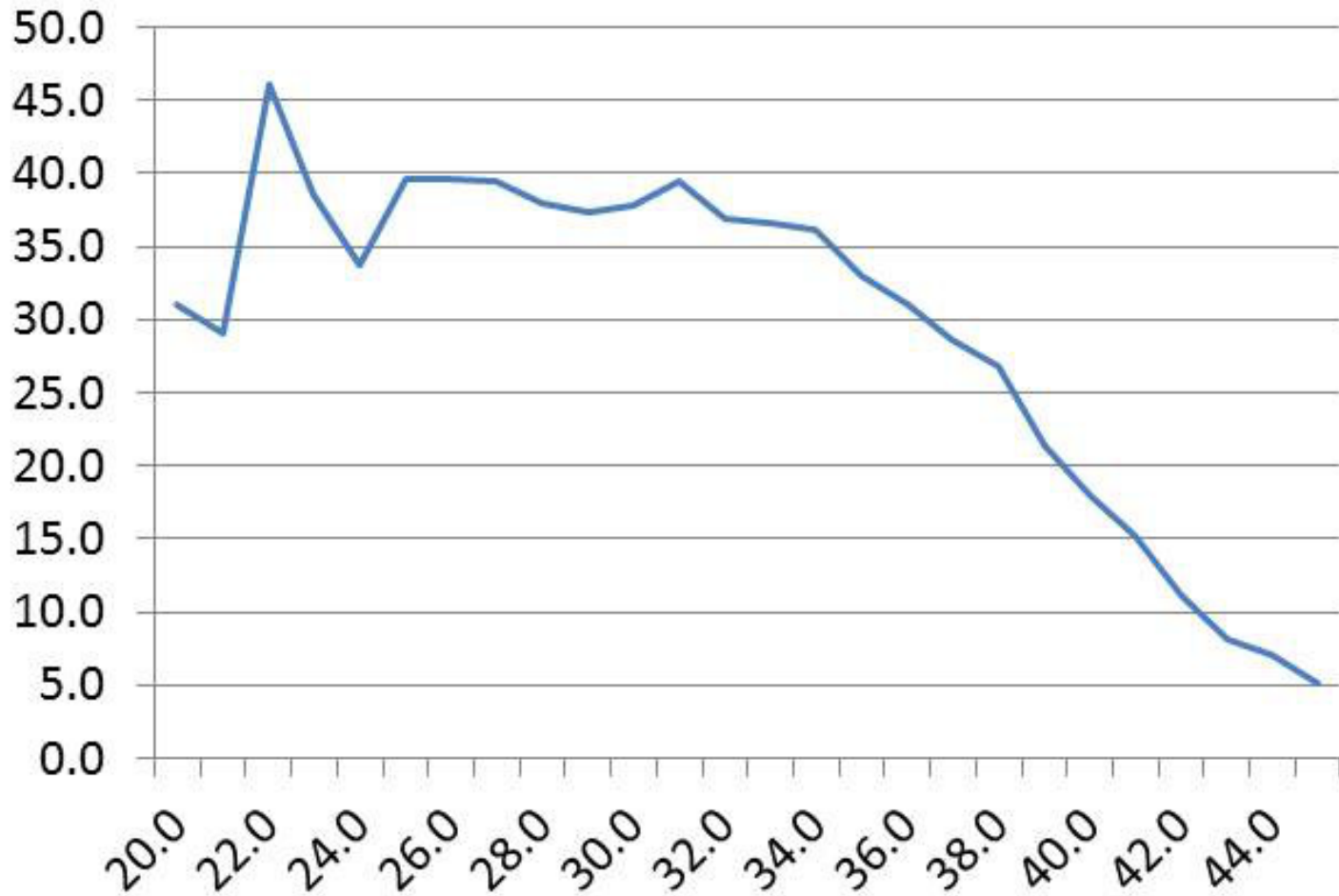

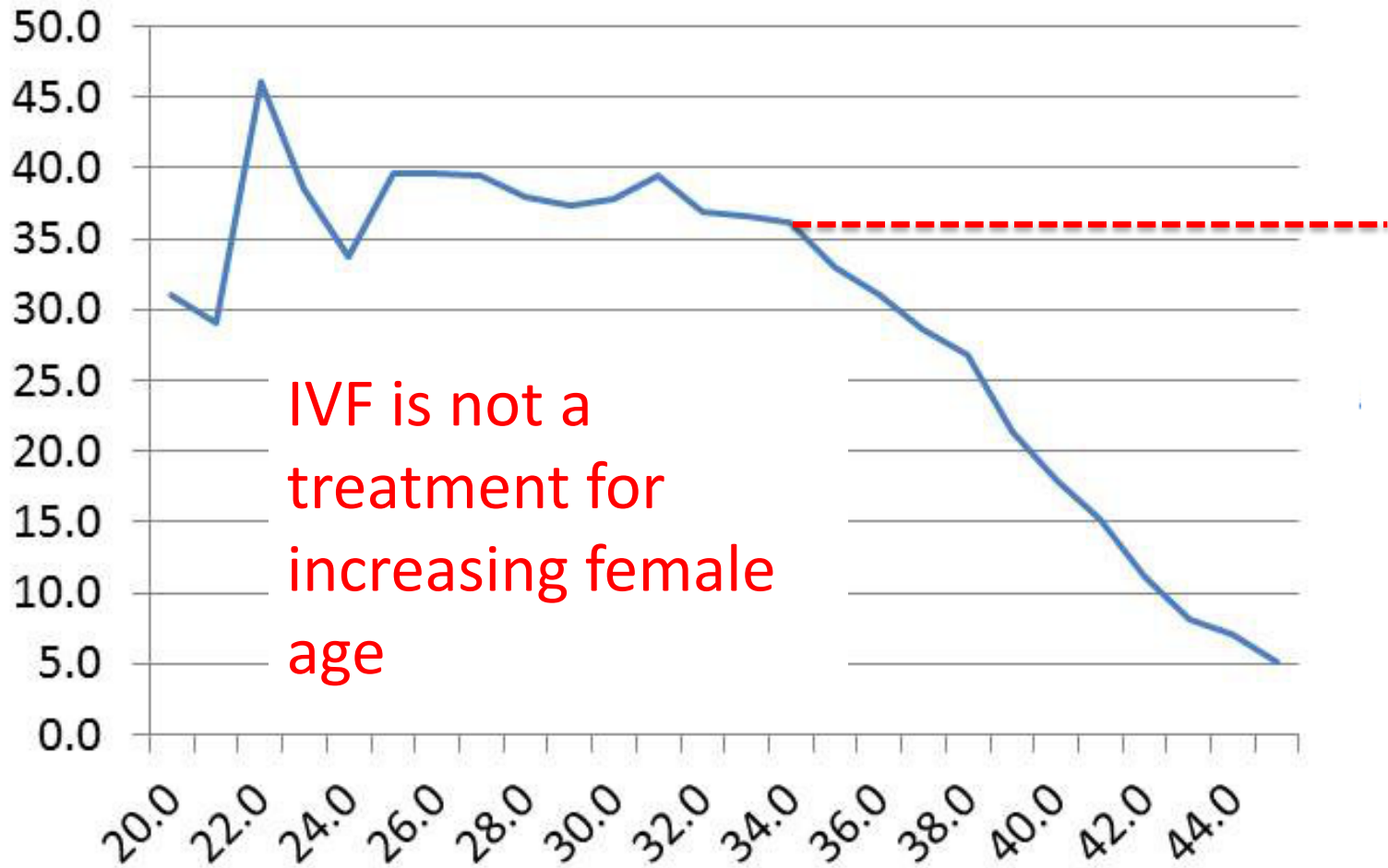
# Annual fertility rate for 100 women not using contraception

18-34	32.9%	32.8%

38-39	20.7%	21.8%
40-42	13.2%	13.7%
43-44	5.4%	4.9%
45+	1.1%	2.0%
<b>All ages</b>	<b>25.9%</b>	<b>26.5%</b>

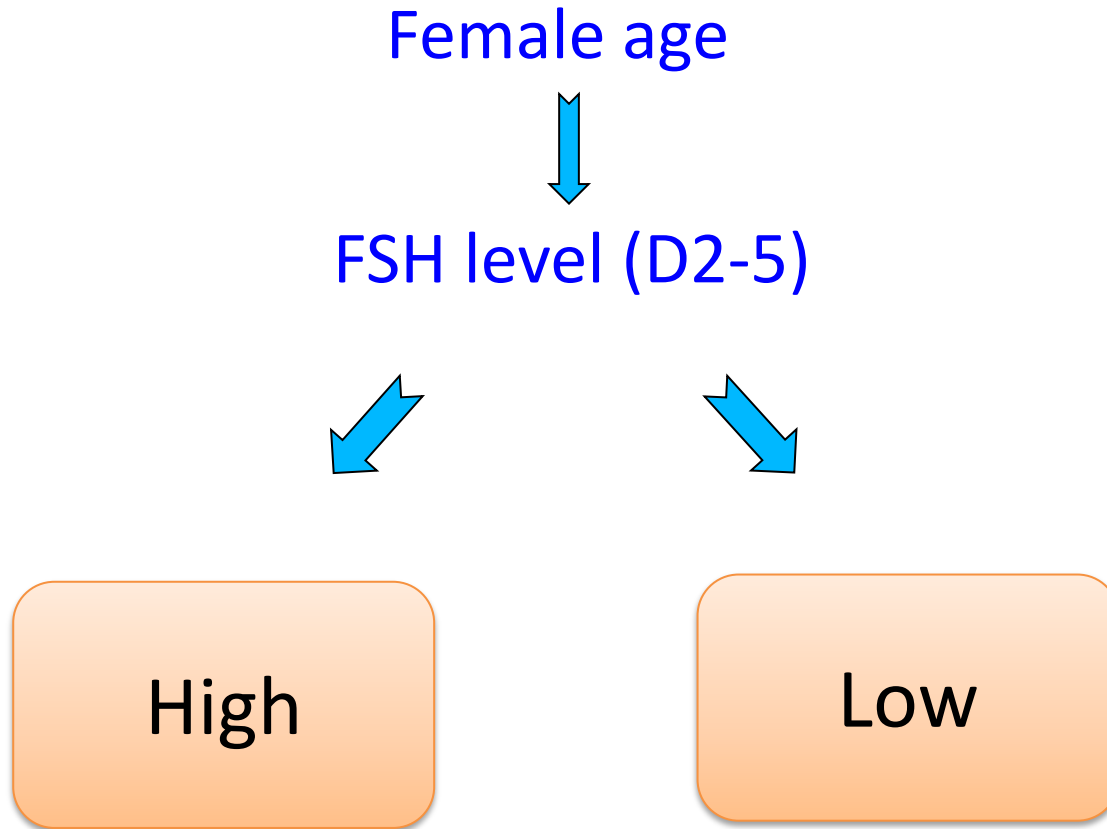

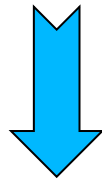

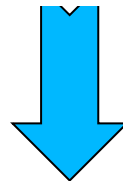
FSH level (D2-5)
